#### **Directions to the Mooseheart Range**

#### From the expressway:

From I-88, exit on Rt. 31 in Aurora. Turn left (north) and take Rt. 31 past Main Street (Rt. 56).....

### From the corner of Rt. 25 and Rt. 56 (Butterfield Rd.):

Go west on Rt. 56 across the railroad tracks and across the Fox River. Turn right (north) at the next light - Rt. 31.....

## Continuing:

Continue going north on Rt. 31 (S. Batavia Avenue) into North Aurora.

After passing Mooseheart Rd., turn left on J. Henry Wilson at the yellow flashing light at the Mooseheart main entrance.

Stop at the security gate, tell them you are here for the Chicagoland JOAD archery tournament. They will ask you to sign in and will give you a visitor's pass to display in your front windshield. Indicate that your destination is the archery range.

Proceed past the gate and make a right on International Rd. and follow it to a fountain in the center of the road. Turn left directly in front of the fountain and follow James J. Davis Rd. straight ahead which passes in front of the Mooseheart Museum on the corner.

Stay on James J. Davis Rd. and go past Pilgrim Road, past a high school on the right, and past Fellowship Road. Turn right on Farm Road, which is a gravel road heading north. The range is on your right just over the hill.

Parking will be allowed just off the side of the road next to a grove of large trees or along the edge of the road.

The speed limit throughout the Mooseheart facility is 20 miles per hour. Please be cautious of pedestrians at all times. There is no smoking or littering on the premises. You may bring tents, but there is plenty of available shade. Porta-potties will be provided as well as bottled water for competitors. You will need to provide your own lawn chairs.
